

Two postdoctoral fellow positions are available for the fall of 2013 in the department of Anatomy and Cell Biology of the Schulich School of Medicine at the University of Western Ontario in London, Canada. One position will lead and effort to investigate how membrane lipids influence vulnerability to neurodegeneration in injury and disease. The other position will develop novel rodent models of Alzheimer's disease to investigate the interaction between stroke and Alzheimer's disease. Our laboratory uses molecular, histological, behavioural, cell culture and novel imaging mass spectrometry techniques. Candidates with experience in these techniques are desired.

We seek enthusiastic and self-motivated early-career scientists within 1 year of completing their PhD. While funding is available to support the position(s), the candidate's CV should be strong enough that they will be competitive (and will be expected to apply for) for National postdoctoral fellowships (i.e. CIHR, NSERC etc.).
